#### **Starksboro Community Survey Results Summary**

As part of its charge from the Selectboard, the Jerusalem Community Center Committee developed and conducted a Starksboro Community Survey in July 2019 to help assess the needs of the community related to replacement of Fire Station #2 and renovation/preservation of the Jerusalem Schoolhouse for use as a community center.


Assistance in the development of the survey was provided under contract with Arc & Arrow Consulting, LLC. The survey was postal mailed to 792 households. The survey was also available to submit electronically through Survey Monkey and was open July 1 – July 31, 2019. During this time two public Listening Sessions were held to receive input from the community as well as to encourage completion of the survey. 153 surveys were completed, 87 online and 66 on paper. The paper surveys were subsequently entered into Survey Monkey allowing for data analysis to include surveys from both formats.

The results of the survey and the community meetings were used by the committee to assist in making decisions regarding community needs and how the project design could respond to the desired functions.




## Years resided in Starksboro





## Household Type
