We are waiting to hear back from Planning Commission. Margi also wrote to Kristen Underwood and she was willing to be involved in this. She would discuss Starksboro alluvial fans and geologic context, history of flooding in Starksboro, how local watershed has fared in recent floods, and potential flooding mitigation techniques. Margi will contact Starksboro historical society (Ruth Beecher chair) about partnering with SCS on that. If it happens, can also potentially partner with Lewis Creek Association.
- 5. Plan to update the bylaws. Robert has made some edits with Herb Olson's comments. We need to spend an hour reviewing and finalizing. Will be scheduled sometime this winter.

6. Signs at the Creekside Trail. Other Creekside Trail maintenance. Not putting out the signs on the trail, due to state of the trail currently. There are signs on the bridges. Norm has been mowing the trail. There is also a big hole on the west side of the bridge. Alice will text Kevin about marking that hole as a first step.
